these "invisible laborers" at sea may be on a vessel of 1000 to 7000 containers, 150 to 300 meters long working in vast ocean lanes that an estimated 100,000 ships may use. They work continuously through 12+ hour days with limited time to eat, use cell phones or devices or tend to personal needs and limited time for socialization in an environment full of deafening ship and ocean noise and constant danger, often with few options to abate exhaustion and loneliness.

We offer free delivery pack and ship services for crews to send packages home and reduced cost transport to food markets, general stores, airports. We will soon offer MoneyGram services.
